Newborn & 03-06month Ripple Burial Gown

Materials: Caron simply soft yarn

Crochet Hook size H

NOTE: For size 3-6 months use crochet hook J

Approx. size for newborn: from neck to bottom edge – 17 inches

Approx. size for 3-6mo: from neck to bottom edge – 20 inches

Row 1: Ch44, dc in 4th ch from hook & next ch, 3dc in next ch, *1dc in each of next 4chs, 3dc in next ch. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of last 3chs. TURN [8points made]

Row 2: Ch3(counts as first st), 1dc in next 3sts, 5dc in next st, *1dc in each of next 2sts, sk next 2 sts, 1dc in each of next 2sts, 5dc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of last 4sts(one will be in the top of the turning ch here and throughout). TURN

Row 3: Ch3(counts as first st), 1dc in next 5sts, 3dc in next st, *1dc in each of next 3sts, sk next 2sts, 1dc in each of next 3sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of last 6sts. TURN

Row 4: Ch3(counts as first st), 1dc in next 6sts, 5dc in next st, *1dc in each of next 3sts, sk next 2sts, 1dc in each of next 3sts, 5dc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of last 7sts. TURN

Row 5: Ch3(counts as first st), sk next st, 1dc in each of next 7sts, 3dc in next st, *1dc in each of next 4sts, sk next 2sts, 1dc in each of next 4sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of next 7sts, sk next st, 1dc in top of turning ch. TURN [96dc]

Row 6: Ch3(counts as first st), sk next st, 1dc in each of next 7sts, 5dc in next st, *1dc in each of next 4sts, sk next 2sts, 1dc in each of next 4sts, 5dc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of next 7sts, sk next st, 1dc in top of turning ch. TURN [112dc]

Row 7: Ch3(counts as first st), sk next st, 1dc in each of next 8sts, 5dc in next st, *1dc in each of next 5sts, sk next 2sts, 1dc in each of next 5sts, 5dc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of next 8sts, sk next st, 1dc in top of turning ch. TURN [128]

Row 8: Ch3(counts as first st), sk next st, 1dc in each of next 9sts, 5dc in next st, *1dc in each of next 6sts, sk next 2sts, 1dc in each of next 6sts, 5dc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of next 9sts, sk next st, 1dc in top of turning ch. TURN [144dc]

Forming sleeves

Row 9: Ch3(counts as first st), sk next st, 1dc in each of next 10sts, 5dc in next st, 1dc in each of next 7sts, sk next 36sts, 1dc in each of next 7sts, 5dc in next st, 1dc in each of next 7sts, sk next 2sts, 1dc in each of next 7sts, 5dc in next st, 1dc in each of next 7sts, sk next 36sts, 1dc in each on next 7sts, 5dc in next st, 1dc in each of next 10 sts, sk next st, 1dc in top of turning ch. TURN [84dc]

Rows 10-33: Ch3(counts as first st), sk next st, 1dc in each of next 11sts, 3dc in next st, *1dc in each of next 8sts, sk next 2sts, 1dc in each of next 8sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with 1dc in each of next 11sts, sk next st, 1dc in top of turning ch. TURN [84dc] At end of row 33 fasten off.

Add a snap or ribbon ties at back neck. Add embellishments.
