




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Gown #2 - Premie

MATERIALS: Caron simply soft or other "limp" type yarn (MC - main color, CC - contrasting color)

Crochet hook size H

Embellishments (i.e. ribbon, flowers, beads, etc.)

Finished size: length of dress approx. 13½" from neck to hem

Gown is open all the way down the back.

Row 1: With MC, Ch35, dc in 4th ch from hook & next 4 chs, 3dc in next ch, *dc in each of next 6 chs, 3dc in next ch. Repeat from * two more times, dc in each of last 5 chs, TURN.

Row 2: Ch3(counts as first dc), 1dc in each of next 5 sts, 3dc in next, *dc in each of next 8 sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, dc in each of last 6 sts, TURN. (leave last st in turning ch unworked)

Row 3: working this row in BACK LOOPS only, Ch3, 1dc in each of next 6 sts, 3dc in next st, *dc in

each of next 10 sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, dc in last 7 sts, TURN.

Row 4: working this row in FRONT LOOPS only, Ch3, 1dc in each of next 7 sts, 3dc in next st, *dc in next 12 sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, dc in last 8 sts, TURN.

Row 5: Ch3, 1dc in each of next 8 sts, 3dc in next st, *dc in next 14 sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, dc in last 9 sts, TURN.

Row 6: Ch3, dc in next 9 sts, 3dc in next st, *dc in next 16 sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, dc in last 10 sts, TURN.

Row 7: Ch3, dc in each of next 10 sts, 3dc in next st, *dc in next 18 sts, 3dc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, dc in last 11 sts, TURN.

forming arm holes

Row 8: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & next 12 sts, sk next 20 sts, sc in next 22 sts, sk next 20 sts, sc in last 13 sts, TURN.

Row 9: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & next 23 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in each of last 23 sts, TURN.
[49sc]

starting skirt

Row 10: Ch1, 1sc in first sc, *sk 1 sc, in next sc work (1dc,ch2,1dc,ch2,1dc) group, sk 1 sc, 1sc in next sc. Repeat from * to end. Ch5, TURN.

Row 11: 1dc in first sc, *1sc in center dc of next group, work group in next sc. Repeat from *, ending with (1dc,ch2,1dc) in last sc, Ch1, TURN.

Row 12: 1sc in first dc, *group in next sc, 1sc in center dc of next group. Repeat from * ending 1sc in 3rd ch of turning ch, Ch5, TURN.

Rows 13 - 30: Repeat Rows 11 & 12 alternately.

Row 31: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, 1sc in each ch sp & st across. Change to CC yarn, TURN.
[73sc]

Row 32: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each across, TURN.

edging

Row 33: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, Ch2, dc in same sp as ch-2, skip next st, *(sc,ch2,dc) in next st, skip next st. Repeat from * across ending with sl st in last st. Fasten off.

Sleeve trim

work like dress edging, one row of sc, join, next row ch1, *(sc,ch2,dc) in same sp as ch-1, skip next st, Repeat from * around . Join to beg sc. Fasten off. Repeat for second sleeve.

Neck edging & ruffles on blouse (missed stitches on rows 3 & 4)

Ch1, *(sc,ch2,dc) in same sp as ch-1, skip next st, Repeat across ending with sl st in last. Fasten off

Weave in all loose ends

Add a big snap to the back of the dress at the neck edge to hold it closed and add embellishments to the front as you wish.

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Bonnet #2 - Preemie

MATERIALS: Caron simply soft or other "limp type" yarn (MC - main color, CC - contrasting color)

Crochet hook size H

Ribbon & embellishments

Rnd 1: With MC, wrap yarn around finger twice, slide it off, insert hook in center of ring & draw up loop, ch3(counts as first dc), work 13dc in ring, [pull beg tail to close up center hole], Join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. DO NOT TURN [14dc]

Rnd 2: Ch3, dc in same sp as ch-3, 2dc in each st around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. DO NOT TURN. [28dc]

You will be working in ROWS now

Row 3: Ch3, dc in each st around to last 3 sts, leave those 3 unworked, DO NOT JOIN, TURN [25dc]

working in FRONT LOOPS for this round ONLY

Row 4: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each across. DO NOT JOIN, TURN [25sc]

Row 5: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, *skip next st, (dc,ch2,dc,ch2,dc) in next st, skip next st, sc in next st. Repeat from * across ending with sc in last st. TURN [6 fans made]

Row 6: Ch5, dc in same sp as ch-5, *1 sc in middle dc of next fan, work fan in next sc. Repeat from * across, ending with (dc,ch2,dc) in last sc, TURN

Rows 7-10: repeat rows 5&6 two more times each, TURN

Row 11: repeat row 5, TURN

Row 12: ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, 1sc in each ch sp and st across. DO NOT TURN [37sc]

Row 13: working around on neck edge, sc evenly across, join to the first sc of brim, DO NOT TURN, Change to CC yarn,

edging

Row 14: Ch1, (sc,ch2,dc) in same sp as ch-1, skip next st, *(sc,ch2,dc) in next st, skip next st. Repeat from * across brim ending with sl st in last st. Fasten off. Weave in loose ends.

Add ribbon and embellishments.

Booties #2 - Premie

MATERIALS:

Caron simply soft or other "limp" type yarn (two colors MC – main color, CC – contrasting color)

Crochet hook size G

Embellishments

Sole approx. 2½" long

Make 2

Rnd 1: Ch8, 3hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1hdc in each of next 4 chs, 6hdc in last ch, working around on opposite side of ch work 1hdc in each of next 4 chs, 3hdc in last st. Join [20hdc]

Rnd 2: Ch2, hdc in same sp as ch-2, 2hdc in each of next 2 sts, 1hdc in each of next 5 sts, 2hdc in each of next 5 sts, 1hdc in each of next 5 sts, 2hdc in each of last 2 sts, Join. [30hdc]

working the rnd in BACK LOOPS only

Rnd 3: Ch2, hdc in same sp as ch-2 & each st around. Join to first hdc (not top of ch-2) [30hdc]

NOTE: to work dec - yo, insert hook in next st, yo, pull loop through(you have 3 loops on hook now). DO NOT yo, insert hook in next st, yo, pull loop through(you now have 4 loops on hook), yo, pull through all 4 loops[dec made].

Rnd 4: Ch2, hdc in same sp as ch-2 & next 10 sts, dec over next 2 sts(6 times), 1hdc in each of last 7 sts, Join to first hdc like before. [24hdc]

Rnd 5: Ch2, hdc in same sp as ch-2 & next 8 sts, dec over next 2 sts(5 times), 1hdc in each of last 5 sts, Join to first hdc [19hdc]

Rnds 6-8: Ch2, hdc in same sp as ch-2 & each st around. Join to first hdc [19hdc]

Rnd 9: Ch2, hdc in same sp as ch-2 & next 9 sts, 2hdc in next st, hdc in last 8 sts. Join to first hdc. [20hdc] Change to CC yarn.

edging

Rnd 10: Ch1, (sc,ch2,dc)in same sp as ch-1, skip next st, *(sc,ch2,dc) in next st, skip next st. Repeat from * around. Join to beg sc. Fasten off.

Weave in loose ends. Fold down cuff. Add embellishments.

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Burial Angel #2

MATERIALS: Caron simply soft yarn (or other "limp" type yarn)

one 1¼" wooden ball for the head

two ½" wooden balls for the hands

one nylon angel wings (the ones I use are 4¾" tall and about 7" wide but I reshape mine a little)

ribbon & embellishments

Crochet hook size G

Approx. size: Angel is about 7" tall without wings

Starting at neck edge of gown, wrap yarn around finger twice, slide off, insert hook in center of ring and draw up a loop.

Rnd 1: Ch1, 6sc in ring. (Pull beg tail to close up hole). Join to beg sc. [6sc]

Rnd 2: Ch1, 2sc in same sp as ch-1, 2sc in each st around. Join. [12sc]

Rnd 3: Working this round in BACK LOOPS only, ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, 2 sc in next st, *sc in next st, 2sc in next st. Repeat from * around. Join. [18sc]

Rnd 4: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, sc in next st, 2sc in next st, *sc in each of next 2 sts, 2sc in next st. Repeat from * around. Join [24sc]

Shaping arm holes

Rnd 5: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & next 2 sts, Ch5, sk next 5 sts, sc in next 8 sts, Ch5, sk next 5 sts, sc in last 3 sts, Join. [10chs, 14sc]

Rnd 6: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each ch & st around. Join. [24sc]

Rnd 7: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, 2sc in next st, *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st. Repeat from * around. Join. [36sc]

NOTES: For beg V-stitch{beg V-st}, Ch4, dc in same st or sp.

For V-stitch{V-st}, (dc, ch1,dc) in next st or sp.

Rnd 8: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, skip next st, *(dc,ch2,dc,ch2,dc) in next st, skip next st. Repeat from * around. Join to beg sc. [9 fans]

Rnds 9: Ch5, turn, dc in same sp as ch-5, sc in middle dc of next fan, *(dc,ch2,dc,ch2,dc) in next sc, Repeat from * around ending with (dc,ch2) in same sp as beg ch-5. Join to 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 10: Ch1, turn, sc in same sp as ch-1, (dc,ch2,dc,ch2,dc) in next sc, *sc in middle dc of next fan, (dc,ch2,dc,ch2,dc) in next sc, Repeat from * around. Join to beg sc.

Rnds 11 - 18: Repeat rnds 9 & 10 alternately. At the end of Rnd 18 fasten off.

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Sleeves

Rnd 1: Attach yarn to any unused st of rnd 5, Ch2, hdc in each st around armhole. Join with sl st to top of ch-2 [10hdc]

Rnds 2-4: Ch2, hdc in each st around. Join. [10hdc]

Rnd 5: Ch1, (sc,ch2,dc) in same sp as ch-1, skip next st, *(sc,ch2,dc) in next st, skip next st. Repeat from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. Leave long tail for gathering. Fasten off. Weave end through skipped sts of last rnd, pull tight to gather, secure.

Repeat for 2nd sleeve.

Neck edge

Working in remaining loops of rnd 2, join yarn, ch1, (sc,ch2,dc) in same sp as ch-1, skip next st, *(sc,ch2,dc) in next st, skip next st.. Repeat from * around. Join to beg sc. Fasten off.

Bonnet

Rnd 1: wrap yarn around finger twice, slide off, insert hook in center of ring and draw up a loop, ch1, 5sc in ring. Join. [5sc]

Rnd 2: Ch1, 2sc in same sp as ch-1 & each around. Join. [10sc]

Rnd 3: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, 2sc in next st, *sc in next st, 2sc in next st. Repeat from * around. Join [15sc]

You'll be working in rows now

Row 4: Ch2, hdc in next 12 sts, leaving last 2 sts unworked, TURN. [13hdc]

Rows 5-6: Ch2, hdc in each st across, TURN [13hdc]

Row 7: Working this row in BACK LOOPS only, ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each st across, TURN [13sc]

edging

Row 8: Ch1, (sc,ch2,dc) in same sp as ch-1, skip next st, *(sc,ch2,dc) in next st, skip next st. Repeat from * across ending with sc in last st. Fasten off.

FINISHING:

Glue head to neck edge inside neck ruffle. Glue small balls one to each sleeve end for hands.

Take a piece of ribbon and run it through sts of last rnd on skirt, pull tight to gather and tie a

bow.

Glue bonnet to head

Add ribbon & charms to front of dress (I sew those on.. everything else I glue)

Glue wings to back of angel.
