





Gown - Preemie

MATERIALS: Caron simply soft or other "limp type" yarn (MC - main color, CC - contrasting color)

Crochet hook size H (i crochet a little tight so you may want to try different size hooks)

Embellishments (i.e. - ribbon, flowers, beads, etc)

Finished size: length of dress approx. 12" from neck to hem

Gown is open all the way down the back.

Row 1: With MC, ch33, sc in 2nd ch from hook & next 4 chs, 3sc in next ch, *sc in each of next 6 chs, 3sc in next ch. Repeat from * two more times, sc in each of last 5 chs, turn.

Row 2: Ch1, 1sc in each of next 6 sts, 3sc in next, *sc in each of next 8 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

Row 3: Ch1, 1sc in each of next 7 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in each of next 10 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 7 sts, turn.

Row 4: Ch1, 1sc in each of next 8 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 12 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 8 sts, turn.

Row 5: Ch1, 1sc in each of next 9 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 14 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 9 sts, turn.

Row 6: Ch1, sc in next 10 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 16 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 10 sts, turn.

Row 7: Ch1, sc in each of next 11 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 18 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 11 sts, turn.

Row 8: Ch1, sc in each of next 12 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 20 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 12 sts, turn.

Row 9: Ch1, sc in each of next 13 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 22 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 13 sts, turn.

Row 10: Ch1, sc in each of next 14 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 24 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 14 sts, turn.

Row 11: Ch1, sc in each of next 15 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 26 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 15 sts, turn.

Row 12: Ch1, sc in each of next 16 sts, 3sc in next st, *sc in next 28 sts, 3sc in next st. Repeat from * two more times, sc in last 16 sts, turn.

forming arm holes

Row 13: Ch1, sc in next 18 sts, sk next 30 sts, sc in next 32 sts, sk next 30 sts, sc in last 18sts, turn.

Row 14: Ch1, sc in next 33 sts, dec over next 2 sts, sc in last 33 sts, turn.

skirt

Row 15: Ch2, 2dc in same sp as ch-2, *sk next 2 sts, (sc, 2dc) in next sc. Repeat from *, ending with sc in last st, turn.

Rows 16 - 44: Ch2, 2dc in same sp as ch-2, *sk next 2 dc's, (sc, 2dc) in next sc. Repeat from *, ending with 1sc in top of turning ch, turn.

At end of row 44 change to CC yarn

Rows 45 - 46: Ch2, 2dc in same sp as ch-2, *sk next 2 dc, (sc, 2dc) in next sc. Repeat from * ending with 1sc in top of turning ch, at end of row 46 Fasten off.

Sleeve

Attach MC yarn to first st of underarm

Rnd 1: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & next 8 sts, dec over next 2 sts (6 times), sc in last 10 sts. Join to beg sc. [25 sts] DO NOT TURN.

Rnd 2: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each st around. Join to beg sc. DO NOT TURN.

Rnd 3: Repeat rnd 2, at end change to CC yarn.

Rnd 4: Ch1, (sc, 2dc) in same sp as ch-1, sk next st, *(sc, 2dc) in next st, sk next st. Repeat from * around. Join to beg sc. Fasten off.

Repeat for other sleeve.

Neck edging

Row 1: Join CC yarn to first ch of neck edge, ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each st across, DO NOT JOIN, turn.

Row 2: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1, ch3, sk next st, *sc in next st, ch3, sk next st. Repeat from * across to last 3 sts, sk next st, sc in next st, sl st in last st. Fasten off

Weave in all loose ends.

Add ribbon and embellish as you wish. I added a big snap at the back neck edge to hold the back closed.

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Bonnet - Preemie

MATERIALS: Caron simply soft or other "limp type" yarn (MC - main color, CC - contrasting color)

Crochet hook size H (i crochet a little tighter than most so you may want to try different size hooks)

Ribbon & embellishments

Rnd 1: With MC, wrap yarn around finger twice, slide it off, insert hook in center of ring & draw up loop, ch3(counts as first dc), work 13dc in ring, [pull beg tail to close up center hole], Join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. DO NOT TURN [14dc]

Rnd 2: Ch3, dc in same sp as ch-3, 2dc in each st around. Join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. DO NOT TURN. [28dc]

You will be working in ROWS now

Row 3: Ch3, dc in each st around to last 3 sts, leave those 3 unworked, DO NOT JOIN, TURN [25dc]

working in FRONT LOOPS for this round ONLY

Row 4: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each across. DO NOT JOIN, TURN [25sc]

Row 5: Ch2, 2dc in same sp as ch-2, sk next st *(sc, 2dc) in next st, sk next st. Repeat from * across, sc in last st, TURN.[12 humps made]

Rows 6 - 12: ch2, 2dc in same sp as ch-2, sk next 2 sts, *(sc, 2dc) in next st, sk next 2 sts. Repeat from * across, ending with sc in top of turning ch. TURN. At end of row 12 change to CC yarn.

Rows 13 - 14: Ch2, 2dc in same sp as ch-2, sk next 2 sts, *(sc, 2dc) in next st, sk next 2 sts. Repeat from * across, ending with sc in top of turning ch, TURN.

At end of rnd 14 DO NOT TURN, DO NOT FASTEN OFF

Continue around on raw neck edge & sc evenly across, join to beg st of rnd 14, TURN.

Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each across neck, DO NOT JOIN [i had 29sc across]. FASTEN OFF

Weave in loose ends & add ribbon & embellishments.

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Booties - Premie

MATERIALS: Caron simply soft or other "limp type" yarn (MC - main color, CC - contrasting color)

Crochet hook size J

Ribbon & embellishments

Finished size: sole approx. 2½"

Rnd 1: with MC, ch6, 2sc in second ch from hook & next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, 5dc in last ch, working on opposite side of chs, hdc in next, sc in each of next 2 chs, 2sc in last. Join to beg sc. [15sc]

Rnd 2: ch1, 2sc in same sp as ch-1, sc in each of next 5 sts, 2sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2sc in last. Join to beg sc. [20sts]

Rnd 3: ch1, 2sc in same sp as ch-1, sc in each of next 7 sts, 2sc in each of next 5 sts, sc in next 6 sts, 2sc in last. Join to beg sc. [27sts]

working in BACK LOOP for this rnd ONLY

Rnd 4: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each around. join to beg sc. [27sts]

Rnd 5: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & next 9 sts, dec over next 2 sts (5 times), sc in next 6 sts, 2sc in last. Join to beg sc. [23 sts]

Rnd 6: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & next 7 sts, dec over next 2 sts (4 times), sc in last 7 sts. Join to beg sc. [19sts]

Rnds 7 - 14: Ch1, sc in same sp as ch-1 & each around. Join to beg sc. [19sts]

at end of rnd 14 change to CC yarn

Rnd 15: Ch1, (sc,2dc) in same sp as ch-1, sk next st, *(sc,2dc) in next st, sk next st. Repeat from * around. Join to beg sc. Fasten off

weave in loose ends. Add ribbon and embellishments.

I added an insole of craft foam.

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Burial Angel

MATERIALS: Caron simply soft or other "limp type" yarn (MC - main color, CC - contrasting color)

Crochet hook size H & G

1½" cabone(plastic) ring

nylon wings

Ribbon & embellishments

with H hook and MC yarn, attach to plastic ring

Rnd 1: ch1, 30 sc in ring. Join to beg sc. DO NOT TURN [30sc]

change to G hook, you'll be working in rows now

Row 2: ch1, 2sc in same sp as ch-1, ch2, 2sc in next st, ch5, sk next 2 sts, 2sc in next st, ch2, 2sc in next st, TURN

Row 3: sl st in each of first 2 sts & into first ch-2 sp, ch3(counts as first dc), (dc,ch2,2dc) in same sp as ch-3, ch2, 8tr in ch-5 sp, ch2, (2dc,ch2,2dc) in next ch-2 sp, TURN

Row 4: sl st in each of first 2 sts & into first ch-2 sp, ch3, (dc,ch2,2dc) in same sp as ch-3, ch2, dc in first tr, (ch1,dc in next tr) 7 times, ch2, sk next ch-2 sp, (2dc,ch2,2dc) in next ch-2 sp, TURN

Row 5: sl st in each of first 2 dc & into first ch-2 sp, ch3, (dc,ch2,2dc) in same sp as ch-3, ch2, sc in next ch-1 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch-1 sp) 6 times, ch2, sk next ch-2 sp, (2dc,ch2,2dc) in next ch-2 sp, TURN

Row 6: sl st in each of first 2 dc & into first ch-2 sp, ch3, (dc,ch2,2dc) in same sp as ch-3 sp, ch2, sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch-3 sp) 5 times, ch2, sk next ch-2 sp, (2dc,ch2,2dc) in next ch-2 sp, TURN

Row 7: sl st in each of first 2 dc & into first ch-2 sp, ch3, (dc,ch2,2dc) in same sp as ch-3, ch2, sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch-3 sp) 4 times, ch2, sk next ch-2 sp, (2dc,ch2,2dc) in next ch-2 sp, TURN

Row 8: sl st in first 2 dc & into first ch-2 sp, ch3, (dc,ch2,2dc) in same sp as ch-3, ch2, sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch-3 sp) 3 times, ch2, sk next ch-2 sp, (2dc,ch2,2dc) in next ch-2 sp, TURN

Row 9: sl st in first 2 dc & into first ch-2 sp, ch3, (dc,ch2,2dc) in same sp as ch-3, ch2, sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch-3 sp) 2 times, ch2, sk next ch-2 sp, (2dc,ch2,2dc) in next ch-2 sp,

TURN

Row 10: sl st in first 2 dc & into first ch-2 sp, ch3, (dc,ch2,2dc) in same sp as ch-3, ch2, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch2, sk next ch-2 sp, (2dc,ch2,2dc) in next ch-2 sp, TURN

Row 11: sl st in first 2 dc & into first ch-2 sp, ch3, dc in same sp as ch-3, dc in next ch-3 sp, 2dc in last ch-2 sp. Fasten off.

Trim on halo

Working in BACK LOOPS only for this row, right side facing, attach CC yarn to first st on right side, ch1, *(sc,2dc) in same sp as ch-1, sk next st. Repeat from * across. Sc in last st. Fasten off.

Working in FRONT LOOPS of stitches you just worked in, join CC yarn with sl st to first st, *Ch3, sk next st, sl st in next st. Repeat from * across. Fasten off.

Weave in loose ends.

Glue wings to back and add embellishments to front. I found the baby rattle in the cake decorating section of our local Walmart store, its made by Wilton.

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
